

Extract of Accompanied Animal Policy

The following conditions are to be applied to all accompanied animals. If you choose to disregard these conditions by leaving your dog or cat in your own vehicle, you subsequently are releasing TT-Line Company Pty Ltd from all responsibility for your pet and from these conditions and responsibilities:

- *All accompanied animals can only be transported in TT-Line Company Pty Ltd provided equipment. An exemption to this is when an accompanied animal is housed in a cage secured on trailers or vehicles with flat trays (refer conditions pertaining to this exemption).*
- Accompanied animals are not permitted for carriage in passenger vehicles or trailers, other than those that comply with TT-Line conditions for the transportation accompanied animals in Kennels Secured On Trailers Or Vehicles With Trays.
- TT-Line does not permit accompanied animals to remain in standard passenger vehicles and road trailers throughout the duration of the voyage due concerns regarding animals welfare.
- TT-Line will provide animals in TT-Line kennels only with water early in the evening and animals will be checked regularly throughout the voyage.
- Provisions of bedding and other requirements are the responsibility of the owner.
- It is recommended by the RSPCA not to give animals solid food prior to or during the sea voyage. It is also recommended that animals be well exercised prior to placing in kennels.
- TT-Line's kennel trolley has been built by an RSPCA approved kennel builder and built to RSPCA specifications.
- The RSPCA recommend that animal(s) for the purpose of transportation, be placed in kennels where there is sufficient room for the animal(s) to stand up **but not to turn around.**
- TT-Line has a maximum of 30 kennels available on any one sailing.
- Passengers should be requested to place their animal in a kennel commensurate with the size of the animals. TT-Line reserves the right to move any animals to another or different size kennel if deemed necessary by TT-Line staff or representative.
- The kennel trolley is located in an adequately ventilated area on the vehicle deck. Please note the vehicle deck is not air-conditioned nor is it cool. As a guide the temperature on the deck is plus or minus 2 to 3 degrees of the current external atmospheric temperature.
- The vehicle deck is frequently tested for carbon monoxide and other toxic atmospheric pollutants. The results of these tests have always been negative and the vehicle decks have been declared safe for both humans and animals.
- Passengers are not permitted to visit their animals during the voyage due to regulatory restrictions.
